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Recording a sentence

There are lots of things to think about when writing down your sentence. The most important step is knowing your sentence by heart.



- Rehearse your sentence until you know it.
- It may help to count the words in your sentence by touching a finger for each word said.
- Then, as you practise, say each word of the sentence as you touch that numbered finger.

Recording a sentence


When you are confident that you can say your sentence:



- Sit up straight and have one hand hold your paper.
- Hold your pen or pencil correctly.
- Start your sentence with a capital letter.
- Ensure there is a finger space between each word.
- End your sentence with an appropriate end mark.

Recording a sentence

Listen carefully to the sentence. Play it again if you need to. Then rehearse the sentence until you know it. Now, try and write it down.
